Our team consists of a lawyer and experienced personnel who have first-hand knowledge of the social benefits system in Alberta, in particular AISH and Alberta Works Income Support.

We can help with:

- Keeping your existing benefits
- Increasing your benefit amount
- Appealing a benefit denial decision or change in benefits
- Obtaining medical documentation
- Preparing for an appeal hearing
- Understanding law and policies that govern benefit programs
- Connecting with community supports

Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH)

Our most frequent request for help involves assisting people with the AISH program.

AISH is financial assistance from the government for people who are 18 years or older and who have a permanent disability that, for the most part, limits their ability to earn a living.

AISH Appeals

If you applied for and were denied AISH benefits, we may be able to help you with your appeal. We may be able to obtain medical documents from your doctor and even attend your appeal hearing with you.
